

**Wexford Leas Swim Club**  
**Rules Regulations**

**1. General:**

1. During operating hours, the swim club, its facilities, premises, and equipment are supervised and maintained by the Pool Manager and lifeguard staff. The Pool Manager and lifeguard staff are charged with the safe operations of the swim club. Their appropriate directions should be followed in all areas of safety, policy, and pool rules and regulations.
2. Members and guests are expected to behave in a generally accepted manner and abide by the Swim Club's procedures and policies. They should refrain from the use of obscene language.
3. There will be no loitering in the parking lot or bicycle area. Bicycles shall be parked in the racks provided.
4. The speed limit in the parking lot is 5 MPH. Violators will be suspended and possibly reported to the Cherry Hill Police Department.
5. The swim club is not responsible for lost, stolen, or damaged personal property.
6. Persons using the swim club's recreation equipment are responsible for its proper use and return.
7. Sale or solicitations or goods or services are not permitted on the Swim Club property other than for the benefit of the Swim Team or Swim Club and with the approval of the Swim Club Board.

**2. Pool Admission:**

1. Weather permitting, the hours of operations are 10 AM until 9pm from the last day of Cherry Hill school through Labor Day. The kiddie pool will open at 10am. Both the main pool and the kiddie pool will be closed for swimming during home "A" and "B" swim meets. The pool is open on weekends beginning on Friday night of the Memorial Day Weekend through the last day of school in Cherry Hill.
2. All entering members must present their membership card and sign in when entering the facility or they may be denied entry. Members must also sign-in any guests by name and purchase or surrender a valid guest pass. Guest passes purchased at the gate are \$7. Guest passes purchased in bulk are \$25 for a book of five.
3. Except on open house and special event days, only active members and their guests will be allowed to use the pool facility. Exceptions can be made by the Pool Manager or a member of the Pool Board. Bondholders and their families are not active members until the annual membership fee is paid and they possess a valid seasonal or monthly membership card.
4. Children less than 12 years of age are not permitted on the premises without a parent or responsible adult.
5. All members less than 12 years of age must pass a swimming proficiency test in order to swim unattended in the main pool. A "High Band" test is necessary to swim in the well, or use the diving board. A "Low band" test is necessary for a child under 12 to swim unattended in the 3 to 5 foot section of the pool and to use the sliding board. Test requirements will be posted and may be altered at any time at the discretion of the Pool Manager and The Board. Those who pass the test will be issued a band which must be worn at all times while swimming. Banded

swimmers are not permitted in the baby pool. Bands cost \$1.00 and are available at the office.

6. Monthly members must purchase a bond, may not purchase guest passes, and may not enroll children in the swim team.

**3. Guest Policy:**

1. All guests must be accompanied by a current active swim club member.
2. Guests must be registered at the front desk with an active member and provide their name, address, and pay a \$7 daily guest fee for a guest pass that they must keep available for the day. Upon registration, the checker will record the guest pass number, the guest's name, the member name and the date in a Guest Log Book.
3. At their option, out-of-state visitors may alternatively purchase a 7-day Weekly Guest Pass for \$20 per person, or for \$50 per family. The issuer of the guest pass must record the guest pass number, the guest's name and the date in a Guest Log Book.
4. Guests who are 12 years of age or older as of June 1, and live in the neighborhoods generally known as Wexford Leas, Old Orchard, Sienna, Fox Hollow or Fox Hollow Woods are limited to three visits per season. Guests who are 12 years of age or older as of June 1, 2007 who live outside of neighborhoods mentioned above are limited to five visits per season. Any guest who is younger than the age of 12 as of June 1, 2007 is limited to seven visits per season. Any exceptions must be approved by the Board of Directors.
5. Active members may host parties at the pool during normal operations hours. All parties are subject to the Party Policy rules and fees posted on the Wexford Leas Club website. Arrangements must be made with the Pool Manager at least one

- week in advance. The Pool Manager and the Board of Directors reserve the right to limit the number of guests or parties, especially on weekends, so as not to inconvenience the membership. Parties that are larger than 10 people also need approval of the Pool Manager and either the President or Vice-President of the Pool Board. Normal guest fees apply. Parents chaperoning children under the age of seven to a party may do so at no additional charge. A limit of one parent per paying guest child. Parties that take place beyond regular pool hours are subject to additional fees. Parties that are larger than 10 guests may require additional lifeguards or Pool Manager on duty, are subject to additional fees.
6. The Pool Manager, Lifeguards on Duty or a member of the Pool Board can ask any guest to leave the facility for any behavior they deem at their own discretion to be improper. If requested to leave, the guest must leave immediately and without incident. The Cherry Hill Police Department may be called as necessary. If a guest is asked to leave, that person may not return to the premises (including parking areas) for any reason for the remainder of the season unless approval is granted from the Pool Board.

**4. Safety:**

1. Members and their guests must observe all rules and regulations of the pool while on the club premises. Violators can be suspended and repeat violators can lose their season membership privileges without financial recourse.
2. Members and their guests shall obey the lifeguards at all times. No person shall distract a lifeguard on duty. Swimmers may also be “benched” for behavior deemed inappropriate or dangerous.
3. The kiddie pool may be used only by children without pool bands and by children less than eight years old. Parents or a babysitter must be present and are responsible for their children while their children are in the kiddie pool area.
4. Unbanded children in the pool are required to be monitored by their parents or babysitter at all times. The lifeguards are on duty to monitor the safety of the entire pool and **not** to baby sit young children in the main pool who have not passed a band test. Lifeguards will be instructed to ask an unbanded child to leave the main pool if that child is not being monitored closely by their parent or responsible adult for the child's own safety.
5. No running, pushing, or horseplay is permitted in the pool, on the pool deck, or on any other area of the swim club facility.
6. Rafts and/or inner tubes may only be used during scheduled times. Approved Personal Floatation Devices (PFDs), including “swimmies” and buoyancy vests, may be used by a young child provided that the parent is in the water, within an arm’s reach of the child. The Pool Manager reserves the right to disallow the use of PFDs based upon pool use at the time or other safety reasons.

7. Only one person shall be on the diving board at any given time. No swimming is permitted in the well area while the diving board is in use. Please check with lifeguard or Manager on duty to close the well for swimming.
8. Diving is prohibited in water depths of five feet or less.
9. The starting blocks are only to be used during swim practices and swim meets, or under the direct supervision of a swim team coach.
10. Open glass containers are prohibited anywhere on the pool premises except in the Club House, Office House or Entrance Lobby.
11. Conduct which endangers the safety and comfort of others is prohibited and shall be reported to the Pool Manager.
12. Persons suspected of being under the influence of drugs or alcohol will be prohibited from entering the swimming area and may be asked to leave the facility by the Pool Manager.

**5. Health:**

1. Members and guests are expected to observe generally accepted health and sanitation rule and practices.
2. Any person showing evidence of any communicable skin disease, sore or inflamed eyes, cold, nasal or ear discharges, or any other communicable disease will be denied admission.
3. Any person with excessive sunburn, open blisters, cuts, or bandages will be denied admission.
4. Do not enter the water if you are experiencing or recovering from diarrhea, or have had any signs or symptoms of a gastrointestinal (stomach) disease in the past seven days.
5. Children who are not fully and completely toilet-trained are prohibited from entering the main pool. **No diapers** are permitted in the main pool. Children who are not fully and completely toilet-trained may use the baby pool, provided that they wear plastic pants or swim diapers with snug fitting elastic waist and leg bands. Do not wash out soiled diapers in the bathing water.
6. Children should be encouraged to use the restroom before entering the water. Immediately report any “accidents” you observe in the bathing waters to a lifeguard, or pool manager.
7. No animals, except for service animals, shall be allowed on the premises.
8. Food and beverages are not permitted anywhere within six feet of the main or kiddie pool perimeter.

9. Smoking is not permitted within ten feet of the main or kiddie pool perimeter.
  
10. All persons shall shower before entering the water.
  
11. Only proper swim attire is permitted in the pool.
  
12. Trash must be placed in the containers provided. Cans and plastic bottles should be placed in the recyclables container.

**6. Conduct**

1. Members and guests will maintain an acceptable level of personal conduct while on the swim club premises.
  
2. Threats of, or actual violence against any member, guests or employee is cause for institution of action to suspend or terminate membership privileges without recourse and/or notification of the Cherry Hill Police.
